  - Cost summary key items: (Estimation based on 70 with 70/20 split on prime rib vs chicken/veg. More prime rib and average meal cost will go up.)
    - Room \$230.95 same as last year
    - Cash bar \$110 went down \$50 Drinks still at \$6 per. Settle your tab at end.
    - \$25.00 per meal, which went up \$2 per meal Includes: Tea, water, green beans, roasted potatoes, dessert
    - \$650 for Prime Rib extra with carver. We will have over 50 for prime rib so \$325 cost is twice. This is \$50 more than last year.
    - Tax (8.25%)+ 18% gratuity
- \$20 per member would cost club \$2409.39

### **Ed Amos 2013 Grand Sport**

Changed cabin air filter in all our vehicles. The C6 with 13,700 needed the change the most. Looks like original filter was in there. C6 cabin air filter compartment is located behind battery. Three clips at the top of compartment door just flip up. Then the door can be removed. Be sure to insert the new filter with the arrow facing downward. Fresh air comes from behind the hood. Those wire clips are very strong so I inserted a flat piece of plastic between the battery and the compartment door. "The wire clips are NOT very strong"
