

# CHEVROLET CORVETTE NEWS

The Corvette Convertible was built in fairly small numbers for the 2020 model year due to production snags caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, accounting for just 17 percent of sales. Customers who were unable to get their hands on a 2020 Corvette Convertible seem to have waited for a 2021 Corvette Convertible, however, as sales of the drop-top model have been much stronger this year.



At the recent National Corvette Museum Bash, Chevrolet revealed that so far, the convertible is accounting for roughly 41 percent of 2021MY Corvette sales. According to Corvette marketing manager Harlan Charles, Chevy has sold 19,362 examples of the 2021 Corvette as of April 1st, which would mean it has sold 7,938 convertibles.

The 2021 Corvette is offered in 12 different exterior colors, two of which are new for the 2021 model year. The most popular exterior color choice for the 2021 Corvette is currently Torch Red.
