



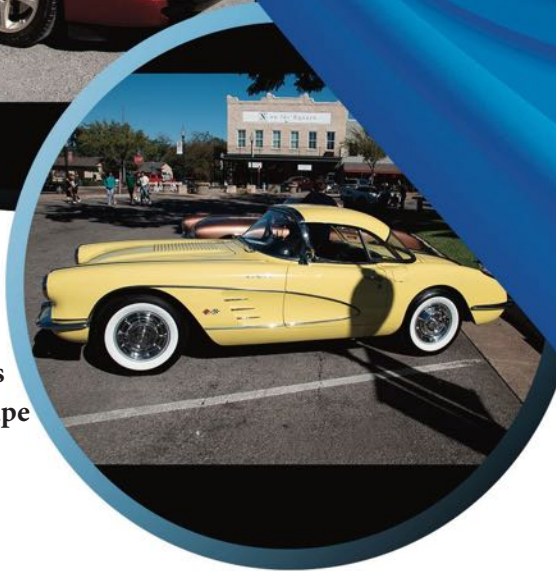
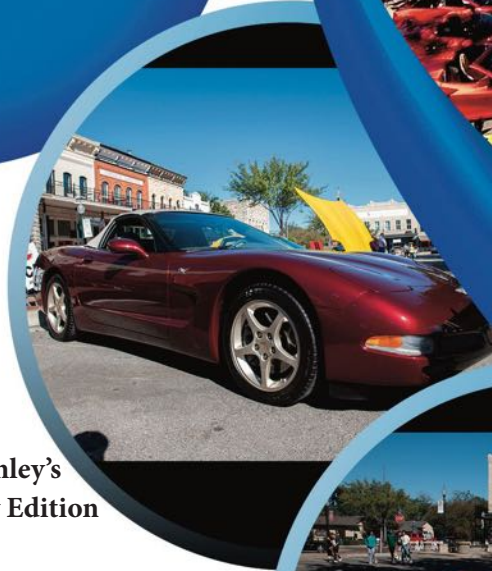

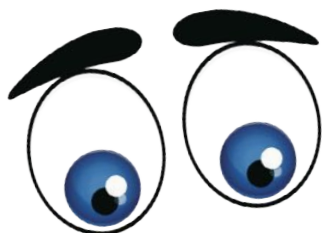

Thanks again, Bob, Theresa, and Nin. Also, thanks to all our members that brought goodies for the potluck and assisted with setup and clean-up.

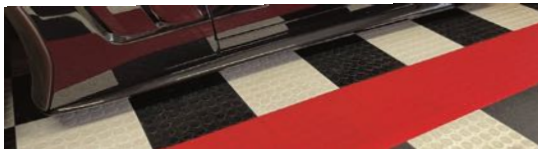




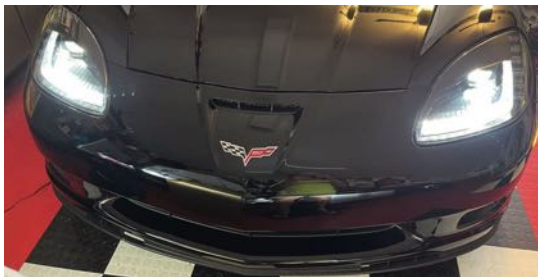
## CORVETTE PARTS & ACCESSORIES

ZR1 Rear spoiler & ZR1 Side skirts



Replaced stock C6 headlights with Morimoto from Amazon : \$1450 a pair. Had JB Corvette Specialists in Carrollton do the replacement: \$800. JB offered to buy my old perfect headlights for \$100. I returned my stock headlights to Morimoto via Original One Parts in Dallas. They said I could get as much as \$600 for perfect C6 lights. They only sent me a check for \$15. Lesson learned.



I bought the Vette Lights LED C6 interior package. Individual LEDs can be bought cheaper but Vette Lights labels each LED pack with its location. LED in: FootWells; Map Lights; and Glove Compartment. The Sun Visors have LEDs but not from Vette Lights. The stock incandescent lights are almost impossible to remove without breaking them. If the stock lights are broken, it's almost impossible to remove the remnants of the broken bulbs. So I bought replacement Sun Visors with LEDs (Amazon) already mounted. There are YouTube videos for mounting the LEDs and the Sun visors. Also, I replaced the rear license plate lights with LEDs from Vette Lights.

## C6 Corvette Driver Flips Ride While Leavin Car Show



Showing off their beautiful car at a show is a highlight for many Corvette owners.

Showing off is often a highlight, too.

Sometimes you can be too flashy, though, as happened Saturday in Ridge, a small town in southern Maryland.

The American Legion Post 255 held its annual car show, and about 4:40 p.m., the driver of this silver C6 Corvette coupe tried to do a burnout, causing his car to leave the road and overturn, according to witnesses.

The good news is that the driver was already out of the vehicle, walking around, by the time police, fire, and rescue personnel responded to the scene at 13390 Point Lookout Road.

With the vehicle resting on its top, it's a wonder he was able to escape from the car. Fortunately, rescue personnel evaluated his condition on the scene, and he ultimately denied transport, saying he wasn't injured.

Smnewsnet.com reports it's not known if any charges will be filed by authorities. It seems this Corvette owner has already suffered enough with the damage to his car – and his pride.





## The Split-window Corvette of 1963

Of all Corvettes, the split-window Corvette of 1963 ranks as one of history's all-time favorites. The 1963 model marked the beginning of the second generation of the sports car's history and was the first time a Corvette would be offered in coupe form. After getting off to a lackluster start in 1953 with an inline six-cylinder engine making 150 hp, the Corvette was not initially considered a serious performance car; poor quality control from its hastily built fiberglass body only further removed it from contention.

A 44-year-old engineer named **Zora** Arkus-Duntov had witnessed the Corvette's introduction at Detroit's 1953 Motorama show and convinced Chevrolet to hire him. By the time Chevrolet began designing the second-generation Corvette, Duntov had been elevated to head of high-performance vehicles at Chevrolet.

Well before the split-window Corvette's arrival in 1963, Duntov had ushered true performance into the first-generation Corvette and Chevy's other performers with the small-block Chevy V-8, high-lift camshafts, fuel injection, four-wheel disc brakes, and some critically acclaimed performances at Pikes Peak and Daytona.

In the postwar auto industry boom of the 1950s, General Motors was a worldwide powerhouse of design and engineering; while Duntov represented the cream of the crop in engineering circles and reported to Chevrolet's then chief engineer, Ed Cole, it was styling guru Bill Mitchell, Chevrolet's chief designer, who was responsible for the 1963 split-window Corvette's silhouette.

The 1963 Corvette coupe's legacy is the car's split-window back glass design. Mitchell's styling vocabulary and his influence within the Chevrolet styling studio was partly an outgrowth

of his curiosity with marine life; sea creatures like the stingray and mako shark had long influenced Mitchell's work, and many anatomical features like gills, wings, tails, and spines would surface in his work. For the 1963 split-window Corvette, the folded crease of the tumblehome represented a spine-like design element that divided the back glass into two halves, allowing this spine element to run uninterrupted from the roof to the rear deck.

Ironically, while the engineering, performance, and styling of the 1963 Corvette Sting Ray was well-received by the public, the split-window back glass was not. The center pillar blocked outward visibility to the rear and quickly became a safety concern. In many instances, owners would remove the two bisected panes and replace them with a single window. Chevy dealerships would even replace the split windows with a single backglass—a cardinal sin in today's Corvette collector environment. After a single year of production, the split rear-window design was shelved for a single back glass in 1964, and the split-window Corvette of 1963 became one of the most notorious (and beloved!) asterisks in automotive history.

# Chevrolet Has Raised the Price of All Corvette Models by \$2,000 Effective October 2nd

Chevrolet dealers received a memo overnight from General Motors announcing a \$2,000 price increase across the board on all 2024 Corvette models. The effective date for this price increase was yesterday, making every new order submitted subject to the price increase.

However, dealers who had submitted orders for the 2024 models and have an 1100 status may have price protection. We’ve seen this before, and having a “price protected” order sometimes means having to fight with your dealer to insure you get it.

Here is what the estimated revised pricing looks for all three Corvette models and their trim packages. Prices include the destination fee of \$1,595:

*CHEVROLET is announcing revised prices effective for vehicles produced on or after October 02, 2023. This revision affects Base Model Prices, DFC, and specific options for 2024 MY CORVETTE. Dealer invoice amounts will increase accordingly. Dealer discounts remain unchanged.*

*Dealer price schedules will be available in GlobalConnect effective October 02, 2023.*

*Retail sold order price protection eligibility dates are dictated by the customer and dealer order dates as follows:*

*-Customer order date must be prior to the date of the price increase.*

*-GM systems order date (date dealer enters in GM system) must be no more than one workday after date of the price increase."*

*These units will be invoiced at prices in effect at the date of production; however, the dealer open account will automatically be credited for the price increase once the unit has been delivered."*

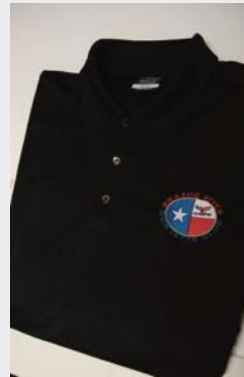
