50/50 raffle will be rolled over to next year. This will make better use of our donated prizes.

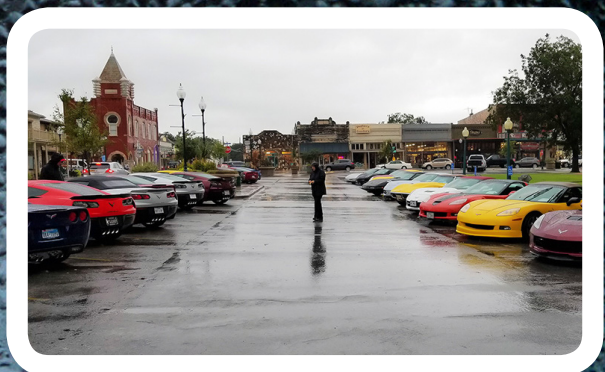
After show dinner was canceled.
